Navigating the High Risk Areas of Patient Support Programs-201 Level Curriculum

Workshops in the 201 curriculum delve into the more complex areas of compliance, going beyond the basics, to promote a deeper understanding into the risks and mitigation controls needed to safeguard compliance programs. There is no pre-requisite to attend.

Workshop Objectives:

- Define Patient Support Programs broadly, and take a deeper look into different elements of these programs including manufacturer-provided copay support, free drug programs, and the role of independent charities
- Identify key stakeholders for patient support programs both inside and outside the manufacturer
- Review the primary laws that may be implicated by patient support programs and how to issue spot using this framework
- Understand the enforcement landscape by looking at specific examples of enforcement across different program elements and see how the enforcement landscape has changed over time
- Discuss compliance considerations and possible mitigation strategies to safeguard programs
- Apply your knowledge gained during this session to fictional scenarios and discuss with your peers how to analyze and advise on novel program concepts
